



Nailsworth Town Council Grants

Nailsworth Town Council (NTC) sets aside money each year for grants to organisations and individuals for projects that improve the community of Nailsworth. The budget at 2016 was £5,250 pa.

Grants

Anyone can apply for a grant, using the form provided. NTC will consider each application according to the criteria below. Grants are for individuals, groups or organisations that show a clear financial need for their project. Receivers of grants will be expected to report back on how the grant money has been used.

Grants will be considered for projects that improve or enhance the town, for example:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• quality of life• recreation, sports and well being• arts• local environment• neighbourhood communities• Nailsworth's history
Grants will not be made:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• for completed projects.• to organisations that discriminate• when there is a duty for a government body to fund the activity• for political activity

Application Process

A Grant Application form must be completed. Where relevant further details should be provided, for example more information about the organisation, a breakdown of the planned spending, etc.

The Council will consider Grant Applications at the next suitable council meeting. Council may ask the applicants to attend the meeting to give a brief presentation, and in any event may ask for further details. Applicants will be notified as soon as possible after the decision and the decision will be final. Unsuccessful applications will be given feedback.

Conditions

Applicants are responsible for ensuring that the project complies with all relevant legislation. Money granted must only be used for the agreed purpose. Any unused money should be returned to Council. Organisations should keep receipts. Money must be used for the project within one year after the grant being made. **A Grant Monitoring Form** must be completed within 6 weeks of completion of the project.

NTC may wish to publicise projects that have received money, and any media coverage should acknowledge the council grant funding.

Context

These Grants are made under the Local Government Act 1972 Section 137 and should directly benefit all or part of the Parish of Nailsworth.
