c) S.16/1825/HHOLD Stable House, Station Road Repairs and restoration of shed / workshop. SUPPORT We are pleased to see the restoration of an historic building
d) S.16/2066/FUL Land Adjacent Ondine Newmarket Road Two new dwellings COMMENT The provision for parking is inadequate for the size of the development. We would expect to see S106 provision for the improvement of pedestrian access in the area.
e) S.16/2011/LBC Stepping Stone Barn Old Market Double glazed units No observations
f) S.16/2062/LBC 2 Stable Cottage Beaudesert Park School, Box Proposed first floor extension and internal alterations. No observations

2016/131 MINUTES AND RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE MEETING OF RECREATION AND AMENITIES COMMITTEE HELD ON 2 AUGUST 2016

The minutes of the meeting of the Recreation and Amenities Committee held on 2 August 2016 were approved. The recommendations of the Committee were proposed by Cllr Myles Robinson and seconded by Cllr Paul Francis, to unanimous support.

RESOLVED: that the rates of hire for Council facilities for 2016/17 be increased by 3% (rounded up).

RESOLVED: that the space in front of the Library should continue to be bookable at no extra charge for those hiring the Mortimer Room and otherwise available for charities, community and political groups to book and use, again at no charge

RESOLVED: that, in addition to the recommended KGV football pitch hire fee of £38 for seniors (£17 for adult training) and £18 for juniors, an additional fee of £15 per hiring be made for dressing the pitch.

RESOLVED: that a charge of £10 per hour be introduced for the use of the KGV changing rooms/showers alone (independent of pitch hire).

RESOLVED: a) to introduce a 'hire of open space' policy for commercial, school and group users and advertise this at KGV Field. This requires businesses and groups to book the field or tennis courts before advertising any events or activities. Charges to be determined in the annual review of charges;
b) to allow the Acorn School to use the changing room showers at a charge of £80 per term to cover utilities, opening/locking and cleaning, to be reviewed as part of the annual review of charges;
c) to require all group users to submit a copy of the Public Liability insurance annually to the Town Hall.
