There have been very positive results from this scheme which has been running since 2011 in Gloucestershire. It is for young people aged 9-17 years old and aims to reduce crime and anti-social behaviour. This is for young people who have not yet gone through the criminal justice system and they have to conform and engage. Anyone can refer a young person if they believe they are engaging in nuisance behaviour or likely to turn to crime. The young people work in the community supervised by the Aston Project, inspiring them to meet their potential in a positive and rewarding environment. They earn credits which they can spend on a reward activity such as a football match or day out to a theme park. Steve would like any ideas for projects around the town e.g. allotments for growing their own food. Advertising will be arranged in Nailsworth News and at the Town Meeting.
