Design Principles

ACCESS: Enabling recreation for all through accessible infrastructure.

LANDSCAPE: Responding to the setting and views of the surrounding landscape.

RECREATION: Facilitating intergenerational play and recreation.

COMMUNITY: Supporting community cohesion and pride.

WILDLIFE: Protecting and enhancing local wildlife and biodiversity.



Design Features

- ① Close mown 1.5m wide path, forming part of 250m perimeter exercise route.
- ② Existing grassland enhanced with wildflower meadow seeding mix.
- ③ Heritage fruit trees to form part of community managed orchard.
- ④ Vegetable and herb raised beds to be managed by local community.
- ⑤ Timber picnic tables surrounding Millennium Oak Tree and daffodil area.
- ⑥ Thinning and crown lifting of vegetation on eastern boundary to improve natural surveillance.
- ⑦ Entrance area with feature pedestrian gate, interpretation board and bins.
- ⑧ Multi-play activity tower suitable for toddlers and juniors with safety surfacing.
- ⑨ Natural play trail utilising existing gradients with log and boulder features and jumping plate.
- ⑩ Multi-stem trees with year-round seasonal tactile interest to form part of natural play trail.
- ⑪ Self-bound gravel 1.5m wide path with timber edging, forming part of 250m perimeter exercise route.
- ⑫ Timber pallisade fencing adjacent to eastern boundary with all-access gates.
- ⑬ Kickabout and run around amenity grass area.
- ⑭ Existing outdoor gym area retained and refurbished where necessary; teen shelter removed.
- ⑮ Gazebo shelter providing viewing point to surrounding landscape.
- ⑯ Ornamental herbaceous planting surrounding gazebo shelter.
