2018/119	Matters of Urgency 1. SDC car parking review: a resident raised questions about the SDC car parking charges consultation. Q: How and when was this council informed that the consultation was halted? A: NTC found out through the press before officially being informed. NTC have had no reply to the 40 questions put to the Strategy and Resources committee.							



	<p>Q: What was the cost to NTC of the response to the consultation?</p> <p>A: This will be supplied by the Clerk to include staff time, banners, printing.</p> <p>Q: If Ove Arup had done what SDC claimed it was asked to do (provide an objective analysis on parking in a small market town), the consultation wouldn't have gone ahead. This is because the evidence would have pointed against car parking charges. NTC was asked to bear this in mind when discussing this matter.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">2. Update on planning application S18/1786 The Maltings, Tetbury Lane; SDC Planning Officers have halted site preparation and construction work. SDC Officers are keen for the site to be developed properly and appropriately.3. Safeguarding complaint: NTC has received a Safeguarding complaint that has been dealt with. Cllrs are reminded that they need to comply with NTC's Safeguarding policy which can be found on the website and cllrs' Dropbox folder.4. Response from NTC on SDC's car park review: <i>*District Cllr Steve Robinson declared a conflict of interest and stayed in the room but didn't take part in the discussion.</i> <p>A draft response to SDC on their car park review was considered. Without Cllr Steve Robinson there were only four cllrs present and Council, being inquorate, could not take a decision. The following points were discussed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• that introducing car park charges to raise revenue is not legal and this needs to be emphasized• that the consultants did not appear to be properly briefed• that a similar approach by SDC has failed in the past and that a change is needed in how SDC conducts consultations and decisions• that a poor quality review took officer time and consultants fees, diverting efforts from other important issues in the district.• that there was a lack of transparency in SDC's process <p>It was noted that three changes to car park regulations for Stonehouse, Painswick and Stratford Park will be decided at SDC's Council meeting on 18 October. The draft response was endorsed by the four cllrs present. It was agreed by those present that Cllr Jonathan Duckworth would circulate the draft response to all for approval and that it would be ratified at the Full Council meeting 6 November.</p>	<p>Clerk</p>

2018/123	<p>To consider the proposed new street name of Hill View for the CLT housing near Lawnside Cllrs felt the name Valley View preferable to Hill View. Valley View had also been suggested by the CLT and more accurately describes the location. It was resolved to recommend the name Valley View. 2018/124	<p>To confirm the date of the Annual Town Meeting as Saturday 27th April The date was agreed. It was felt the new Town Meeting format in the marquee went very well. Cllrs/Arkeil Centre Trustees need a rota to staff the stall. A plan of all stalls to be made available to the public. It was felt the event could be longer but other felt it gave time for people to do other things in the day. Some felt heating might be beneficial. There needs to be a formal part to the event to conduct the business of the Town Meeting. It was resolved to allow the Clerk and Cllr Jonathan Duckworth to plan the event in more detail and bring this to Council.
