<p><b>Declarations of Interest &amp; Applications for Dispensations</b>  There were no declarations of interest or applications for dispensations. Cllr Ron Kerby said he had suggested a contractor for item 2 but these have been anonymised</p>	
<p><b>To consider replacement of windows at Hazelwood bungalow with double glazing</b>  Cllr Ron Kerby noted only one of the quotes includes trickle vents which helps prevent condensation and mould.  Cllr Myles Robinson <b>recommended</b> Quote 3  Cllr Myles Robinson proposed, seconded Cllr Jonathan Duckworth and agreed unanimously</p>	<b>Clerk</b>
<p><b>To consider additional surface painting for skate ramps</b>  Cllr Jonathan Duckworth proposed, seconded by Cllr Steve Robinson and agreed unanimously.</p>	<b>Clerk</b>
<p>The Clerk was asked to check with the Groundsman if a new bin was needed at the skate ramps.</p>	<b>Clerk</b>
<p><b>To consider repairs and cleaning of the War Memorial for 2018</b>  The Clerk outlined a proposal to make repairs to the war memorial. Cllr Jonathan Duckworth said his stone mason commented there's a gap between the war memorial and the church's land to help clear encroaching shrubs.</p> <p>It was noted the names on the stone plaques at the back of the memorial had been replicated in brass plaques in the early 1990s. The stone is very soft and any work should take into consideration the need not to present a pristine memorial but one with the patina of age. The main need is to remove vegetation from behind the wall (in the churchyard), do necessary work to reset paving slabs and any other repairs.  Cllr Steve Robinson said NTC should involve the Royal British Legion and the church early in this project.</p> <p>Cllr Ron Kerby to contact Church Warden (Martin Stone or Roger Lewis) to discuss.</p>	<b>RK</b>
<p><b>To consider locking pedestrian gates at KGV Field at night</b></p>	<b>Clerk</b>

<p>There was some discussion over whether locking the pedestrian gates would prevent anti-social behaviour in the park at night. It was felt that, as there is an unlockable pedestrian access between the tennis courts and the play area there would be no benefit in locking the pedestrian gate at the main entrance.</p> <p>Option 2 was suggested, to leave the gates as they are and to monitor ASB in the park through the summer.</p> <p>Proposed Cllr Myles Robinson seconded Cllr Anne Elliott and agreed unanimously.</p>
