A paper will be put together for the next meeting. • Cllr Anne Elliott-matter arising from the minutes of 19th March. She feels it is unrealistic to restrict a meeting to 1.5 hours. Could this be a trial instead of changing standing orders. This will have to come back to full council anyway. Cllr Jonathan Duckworth stated that Council should remember that a Budget was not an agreement to spend all the money in the budget. Council has a duty to electors to achieve best value. It was resolved to approve a budget of £2,780 and a contingency budget of no more than £500. Proposed by Cllr Robert Maitland, seconded by Cllr Ron Kerby, agreed unanimously.</p>
