- e) S.20/0157/TCA. Old School House, Watledge Road, Nailsworth, Stroud. Yew tree to the side of the house – reduction in height. Application approved. NTC - More detailed reasons for the reduction in the height of the tree would be useful. In the light of Nailsworth Town Council and Stroud District Council's declaration of a Climate Emergency the loss of any tree requires justification and proposals for mitigation, and the District Council should be developing a policy to ensure that no mature tree within the district is lost without clear justification.
- f) S.20/0215/TCA. Unit 1, Spring Mill Industrial Estate, Avening Road, Nailsworth. Works to various trees. Application approved. NTC – No observations.
- g) S.20/0092/TCA Location: 1 Dunkirk Bank, Theescombe, Amberley, Stroud. Application Type: Trees in a Conservation Area Description: Conifer (T1 & T2) - fell one and reduce the height of the other. Eucalyptus (T3) - crown reduction Hazel (T4) - lift crown, remove some larger lower branches Apple (T5) - continue

ongoing renovation by reducing height of taller branches. Application approved.
