<b>Declarations of Interest &amp; Applications for Dispensations</b> None	
<b>To receive a verbal update on the results of the Mural Competition and discuss actions going forward</b> Cllr Sally Millett announced the results of the mural competition (200 votes were received), the entry with the most public votes is 'Flowing Water and Weaving Cloth' by David Austin with John Rodgers. It was discussed that the other designs might be used elsewhere in the town. Cllr Sally Millett will ask for the artists permission for us to look in to this. Cllr Robert Maitland said we must consider potential sites and image rights.	<b>SM</b>
<b>To consider presenting a town sign to Leves at the Mayor's visit to France next year</b> It was recommended a town sign is presented by the Mayor at the next visit to Leves in the first weekend in May.	<b>Recom to full council</b>
<b>To consider a proposal on town maps from Marcus Walters</b> There was a discussion during which the following points were raised: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The proposal is excellent and very clear</li> <li>• The towns visual identity is very important</li> <li>• On the map the area could be slightly larger</li> <li>• The map to show 'Shopping, restaurants, cafes'</li> <li>• On the map 'Civic Centre' to be renamed</li> </ul> It was agreed to ask Marcus to proceed with the deliverables and objectives, and to put together a more formal proposal detailing the process and an estimate for each component, as he had suggested.
