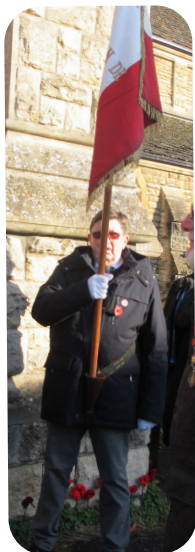

Please let Isobel know by 24th October at the latest if you wish to join us for lunch.



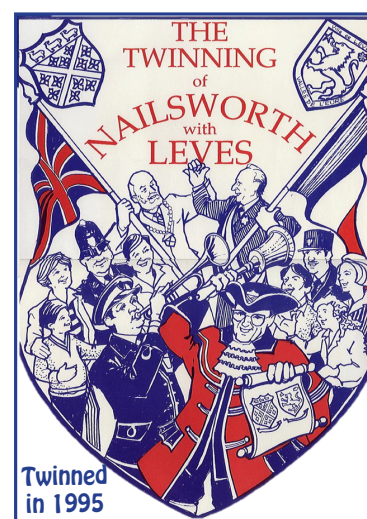
LEVES CORNER GARDEN

2023 TWINNING TRIP TO LÈVES : Saturday 27 to Tuesday 30 May



Twinnings will join about 35 players & partners from the Nailsworth Silver Band who have booked the coach and have a van at their disposal to carry the instruments.



Departure on the Saturday will be from Nailsworth bus station at an early hour, arriving in Lèves early evening, Brexit regulations at Dover permitting! We will leave Lèves on Tuesday morning, getting back to Nailsworth around midnight.

The booking form will be sent out separately in WORD format. Please complete and return it to Isobel by 15th November latest. Final costs will depend on numbers but we anticipate this will not be more than £100 a head. We may be able to offer a reduced rate for under 16s.

PLEASE NOTE: Your passport must be:

- Issued less than 10 years before the date you enter the country (check the date of issue)
- valid for at least 3 months after the day you plan to leave (check the expiry date)

You can apply for a free GHIC medical insurance card (this has replaced the EHIC card but provides the same medical cover) <https://www.gov.uk/global-health-insurance-card> and/or arrange your own travel insurance if you so wish.

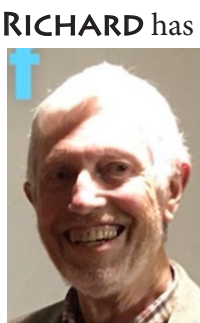
