NTC would like to remind the planning authority that the original planning application for this development was controversial and there were almost 1000 individual written objections from Nailsworth people. It was turned down by the LPA but was eventually given permission on appeal. One of the reasons for allowing the appeal was the claimed quality</p>



			<p>of the design. The developer is now seeking to degrade the design by changes to fenestration and building size and mass. This would have the effect of making this intrusion into the valley still more prominent. NTC oppose the changes very strongly.</p> <p>The original application went to DCC for determination.
