**To consider accepting a gift of land at Carters Way for use as a community garden/allotments**

Thanks were given to Cllr Patsy Freeman for all of the work she has put in to the Carters Way project.

It was **recommended** that NTC accept the gift of the land at Carters Way and start the legal land transfer immediately at an estimated cost of £1,800

**To consider a midsummer Ash dieback survey for NTC's tree stock at a maximum cost of £1,000**

It was **recommended** to agree to a midsummer tree survey at a cost of up to £1,000

**To consider development of the Calvium App**

There was a discussion regarding the positive development of Tourism in the town and the improved links with the Markets Towns and SDC that has come from this work.

It was **recommended** to recommend an initial budget of up to £1,000 (Approximately 12 days of work) for a student to upload an input trails on to the Calvium App

**To consider an amendment to NTC's Open Spaces Policy to outline the procedure for dealing with illegal encampments on NTC land**
